# SHELTER GUIDE

## Things You Should Know

- ↑ Where possible, two people should erect the shelter.
- ↑ Do not fully extend the frame until the canopy is attached. This is because the further the frame is pulled out the higher the centre post goes, making it difficult to pull the canopy over.
- ↑ We recommend the first time the shelter is used that the moving joints are lubricated with WD40 or a silicone spray.

Open and remove the frame from the box.

Standing at opposite sides of the frame, hold a leg in each hand. Carefully lift the frame slightly off the ground whilst moving backwards to extend the frame outwards until the legs are an arms width apart.

Remove the canopy from the box, unfold it and locate the corners.

Carefully pull the canopy over the top of the frame and ensure all corners are placed in position.

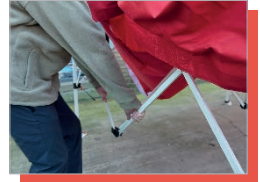

Stand opposite each other and take hold of the cross bars, walk the frame out at far as possible.

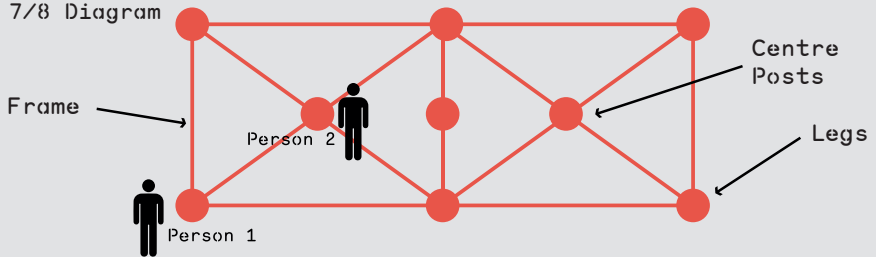
Your frame should now be fully extended outwards.

To extend the shelter upwards person 1 should stand at one of the corner legs, with person 2 holding the nearest centre post underneath the shelter (there are three centre posts on a 6 leg shelter).

The person at the corner leg needs to push the sliding joint up. At the same time person 2 needs to push the centre post up until it clicks into position. This will extend the framework upwards even further. The pin should locate in to the hole at the top of the leg. Once this clicks into place repeat with the remaining 5 legs and push the sliding joint into place.

# INCREASING HEIGHT

## Things You Should Know

⤴ If you are having trouble getting the sliding joint to click into place, roll the valance up slightly, this will give you a bit more room to push the joint up. Once located, just roll the valance back down.

⤴ There are five different height settings on the leg.

⤴ Once the shelter is extended to its full size, push the legs upwards to increase the height.

⤴ To do this, pull the red ring at the bottom of the leg and the inner leg will slide out.

⤴ Pull the inner leg down and it will automatically locate in to the first height setting.



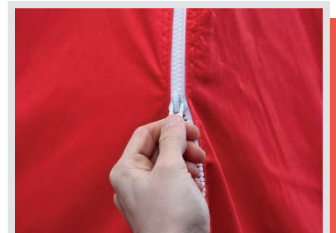
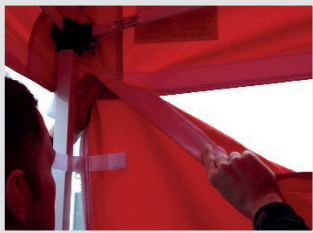
⤴ When lifting the outer leg, put pressure on the footplate so the inner leg extends.

⤴ Once you have completed one side, move over to the opposite side, until all legs are extended to your required height.

# ATTACHING SIDES

Firstly, find the side of the sidewall with the long strip of velcro and align it to the long piece of velcro on the inside of the canopy at the bottom of the valance.

Move along the wall attaching the velcro in small increments making sure it is tight.



Once the velcro across the top is attached, wrap the velcro straps around the frame leg.

Zip the next wall to the shelter and continue to attach the velcro.

## Things You Should Know

The sidewalls are designed to be a tight fit, this ensures they look neat and professional, if you struggle to join the last side, use the additional joining strip we provide with all sides. We recommend using this for the first few uses of the shelter, until the material stretches slightly.

If more than one piece is required it means that the sidewalls aren't being pulled tight enough.

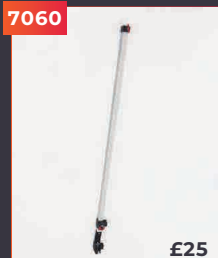
